

ACCURACY OF THE BIBLE

When William Tyndale was discussing a theological point with a cleric who argued that men would be better off without God's law than without the Pope's law, Tyndale retorted that "if God spared his life, before long he would make the boy who drives the plow know more Bible than the cleric did", Jack P. Lewis, The English Bible – From KJV to NIV, pg. 9. The entire history of the English Bible can be seen as a movement in the direction of Tyndale's goal, to make the Bible available and plain to the common man.

Christianity firmly believes the Bible is the inspired Word of God. This the Bible affirms for itself in 2 Timothy 3:16-17, "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works." It also says the very words are the words of God. 1 Corinthians 2:12-13 says, "Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual." Therefore we believe in the plenary, verbal inspiration of the word of God, that is, that God's inspiration extends to every part, every subject, and every word of Scripture. We believe that God's Word is our guide to living as God would have man to live and how He expects man to worship and serve Him.

The Bible, containing 66 books, was written by 40 different inspired men over about 1,600 years. The Old Testament was written in Hebrew and small portions in Aramaic and the New Testament was written in Greek. We do not have the original writings of these inspired men. What we have now are copies of copies of copies called manuscripts. Someone may wonder about the accuracy of the copies we have. At one time, the oldest full copies of the Old Testament were from 1008 AD. However, with the discovery of the Dead Sea Scrolls in 1947, the Biblical manuscripts which were thought to have been written between 100BC-100AD, when compared with existing manuscripts, showed no major errors. In this the Dead Sea Scrolls demonstrate that the Old Testament was accurately transmitted during this time period.

What about evidence for the accuracy of the New Testament? Keith A. Mosher, Sr. writes, "New Testament credibility is firmly established by the voluminous amount of the manuscripts available. However, the evidence from the first 2½ centuries after Christ, because of the persecution of the church, is mostly fragmentary. Yet, even the fragments, when pieced together, give the unique impression of a unified text as early as the 2nd century of the Christian era." The Book God "Breathed", pg. 355. With these fragments, as well as full texts, the New Testament manuscripts number nearly 6,000. There are also quotations of the so called "church fathers" which number some 36,000 quotations. Also there are the Bible versions from the 2nd century such as the Syriac, Latin, Coptic, etc. which number nearly 10,000.

Indeed, with all this evidence we can be sure of the accuracy of our Bible.

"Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away"- Matthew 24:35.
