### 2016...What Will You Do?

With the passing of 2015 another year is upon us. With the coming of the New Year many of us will turn our minds to those changes we would like to make in 2016. While I am not a champion of "New Year's Resolutions" which are here for a time then vanish away, I do however agree with the idea of self-reflection and correction at any time of the year. This writer also considers the time gone by and the coming year ahead and ponders, "what can I do, or do better, in the service of the Lord in the coming year?"

Have we considered beginning a Bible Reading Schedule to read the Bible through in the coming year?
