One will be held on Saturdays in the evenings and the other will be on Sunday morning. Both of these studies are open to anyone and everyone who wants to attend and are opportunities to study for people who work during the week or have other commitments on Sunday evenings (a usual church time here). NEW ADDRESS

While our schedules have simultaneously slowed and filled at the same time, we had an extra complication thrown into the mix this month. Our contract for our first house was coming to an end and the landlady decided she and her family would be moving back in once the contract ended. This meant we had to start house hunting quickly! We had already discussed maybe moving somewhere more centrally located to help with transportation needs for those attending our studies, but our minds were made up for us when she decided they needed to be back in the house by August 1st. Thankfully we were able to find a house quickly. It's a great house that is located closer to the kids' school, closer to people who study with us and main roads, and one with an actual back yard with grass. The kids were most excited about the backyard- it is very common to build to fill your lot here, which means green spaces are rare. We are all still adjusting to the new space but we think this house will better fill our needs for the work here. We were able to host church service on August 6th and were actually able to start a kids Bible class! This house has an extra office space attached to the house that we will be using for Bible classes and group studies. We are so excited to share these spaces with everyone. Please be in prayer with us as the work here continues to grow!




