While we were in Lima we were able to look at a few vehicles. Unfortunately, we did not find one we were willing to move forward with during this trip, so the car hunt continued!

We also spent much of our time finalizing things for our first ever team!

We made preparations for fifteen individuals from Rome Church of Christ to come and spend a week working with us in Huancayo! There was a lot to organize- food, lodging, transportation, venues for the works we would be doing, etc.- and thankfully we got everything squared away before their arrival. We also spent time advertising for the events the Rome team would be working on. We passed out flyers for a Bible conference and kids club. Thankfully we had many willing hands here in Huancayo to help us spread the word! We were encouraged to see so much excitement for the upcoming events.

During the month of May our studies continued as normal. Though that might not be such an exciting update, we are encouraged that the individuals here have continued to show interest in studying the Bible with us. Our schedules are full, but it is an uplifting full!

June was a very hectic, but very fruitful month for us! We started the month by (finally) finding a vehicle! Unfortunately, the timing wasn't excellent, and Daniel ended up driving it home from Lima the night before the team arrived. We are so thankful to have our own vehicle. Thankfully all fourteen members of the group made it safely up the mountain with all of their luggage, including Audrey's mom, brother, and sister! We had a busy week planned for them, and thankfully they all had a great attitude about the busy schedule and long days. Most mornings were spent prepping for the day's activities, followed by a kids' club in the afternoon, then a Bible conference in the evenings. We celebrated Father's Day together by cooking a traditional Peruvian Pachamanca. It was a treat for the team and for the people from our studies. We also managed to squeeze in a few trips to the orphanage by our home. Both the kids club and trips to the orphanage have opened doors into new parts of the community. Please be in prayer as we decide how to pursue these new outreach opportunities. The Bible conference was also a success. We held the conference in a government building in the middle of downtown, making it a great spot to meet new people. We had over 140 people in attendance! We made several new contacts, most asking to set up Bible studies with us. We hope we see fruit from this conference for years to come. People here have already asked if we will be putting on another conference next year, and our answer is we hope so! We would love to make this an annual outreach opportunity.
