We are located between two main roads and close to universities, so public transportation is much easier to find now. All of our usual studies have continued and grown. We have several group studies- I think we have a total of four- in addition to our individual studies throughout the week. Worship has continued in our house every Sunday (and we now have the sign out front to prove it haha). Once the sign was placed we had several neighbors ask us about the church. The kiddos are both doing well. They are learning more Spanish every day! It's sweet to hear their little voices sing songs from school in the back seats of the car.

We also wanted to update everyone on our plans for the baby. We found out last month that we will be welcoming another little boy into our family! We are all excited for his arrival. Our current plan is to have the baby here in Peru. We will travel to Lima, the capital of Peru, for the birth around the end of November or beginning of December. We have found an amazing clinic (private hospital) and are confident both Audrey and the baby will receive great care there. Once the baby is born we have to apply for several documents, both from Peru and the United States, before we are able to travel. Our hope is to be able to visit everyone stateside in January or February, but this timeline depends greatly on the paperwork process. Please be in prayer for us, for the birth of our son, and that the paperwork will be processed quickly so we can visit friends and family as soon as possible.
