LOTS HAPPENING!

Everything here in Huancayo continues in full force. The congregation meeting in our home continues with weekly worship, in addition to several group and individual Bible studies throughout the week. We are sad a few families have moved away from Huancayo in the past few weeks, but we are also encouraged several new people have started attending studies and worship. We hope these new folks will continue to attend and that their hearts will be open to the Gospel. As numbers grow, we have begun to consider the need for a larger local to host worship services. Ideally, we would like this to be the responsibility of the folks here in Huancayo. However we also recognize that there are severe financial limitations for most of the people here, so providing their own building may be impractical. Please be in prayer with us and the church members here as we consider the future plans of this young congregation.

NEW BABY IS ALMOST HERE!

As we mentioned in our last update, we have a new baby boy, Levi, on his way! Audrey is scheduled for a c-section on December 2nd, so we will be traveling to Lima the last week of November in preparation for the birth. We will remain in Lima for a couple of weeks after the birth as Audrey and Levi have some follow-up doctor's appointments. During this time we will also be filing both Peruvian and US paperwork to get the documents required for the baby. Once we have Levi's US and Peruvian passports (he will be a dual citizen) we will be able to finalize travel plans for the US. Our hope is to be able to visit everyone stateside in January or February, but this timeline depends on the paperwork process. Please be in prayer for us, for the birth of our son, and that the paperwork will be processed quickly so we can visit friends and family as soon as possible.

UPCOMING VISIT TO THE US

As mentioned previously, we are planning a visit to the US at the beginning of 2024. While we are in the States we will be traveling to our supporting congregations to give an account of the work that has been taking place over the last 18 months. We expect this visit to be 8-10 weeks as we travel giving updates, so if you or your congregation would like to have us come and share about the Lord's work here in Peru please contact us via one of the methods listed below on page 3.
