My God is So Big

When my kids were little, I loved to hear Renee sing to them. She would sing many different types of children's songs, but the ones I really loved were the ones that taught them about God. There was one song in particular that I still hear in my mind that she would sing; the song goes like this: "My God is so big, so strong and so mighty. There's nothing my God cannot do." Wow! What a message, fitting for young and old alike. The question is, do you believe that? Can you honestly say that your God is so big, so strong, and so mighty and that there is nothing that He cannot do?

The children of Israel sang a song very similar. When they crossed the Red Sea, they sang "The Song of Moses":

"I will sing to the LORD, for he has triumphed gloriously; the horse and his rider he has thrown into the sea. The LORD is my strength and my song,

and he has become my salvation;

this is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will exalt him.

The LORD is a man of war;

the LORD is his name." (Ex. 15:1-3)

They sang about God's power, His majesty, and His holiness. They sang about how the inhabitants of Canaan were all trembling and full of dread and terror because of God's marvelous works in Egypt. But somehow along the way they had forgotten that song. When they went in to spy out the land, they forgot about the God who had destroyed Egypt and Pharaoh's armies.
