Gospel Meeting

Our Gospel Meeting this week is a wonderful opportunity for spiritual growth, encouragement, and renewal, and we should approach it with eager and thankful hearts. As James teaches, we must be doers of the word and not hearers only (James 1:22). If we come with humility and a desire to grow, this meeting can strengthen our faith, deepen our understanding, and draw us closer together as a congregation.

May we all commit to supporting this Gospel Meeting with enthusiasm, faithfulness, and a spirit of unity. The blessings we receive will be directly tied to the effort we put into it. Let us make the most of this opportunity and encourage one another each night as we gather to hear and obey the life-changing message of the gospel.
