GOING WITH THE GOSHORNS

MISSIONARY FAMILY SERVING IN PERU



FOUR YEARS IN HUANCAYO!

Wow! We cannot believe that we have been living in Huancayo, Peru for four years already! Over the course of the past several years we have had an abundance of highs and lows, heartaches and happiness, trials and celebrations. Since leaving Kentucky we have added a third child, formed relationships with dozens (perhaps hundreds) of Peruvians and Venezuelans, had more Bible studies than we can count, and learned more than we can ever express. We want sincerely to thank you for the prayers and support shown by so many. Without the partnership of dozens of members of the body of Christ we would have never come to Peru in the first place, and we would not have been able to remain this long. So again, we thank you for making this work possible here in the Andes Mountains of Peru.

WHAT THE LORD HAS DONE SO FAR: 2022-2026

Since 2007 we have had some form of connection with Huancayo, Peru. Daniel was only 12 years old when he came here for the first time on a short-term mission trip. . With our long history with this city of almost 500k people, we have felt the need for the Gospel and the establishment of a congregation of the church of Christ for a long time. In June of 2022 the Lord made it possible for us to move full-time as missionaries to Huancayo. Now, four years later, we can look back and see God's hand at work in all that has happened here.

Our work in Huancayo consists primarily of individual and group Bible studies. While this might be as glamorous sounding as other types of ministries (building schools, providing medical care, drilling water wells, etc.) we believe it is the most important aspect of any mission effort. Other types of works can certainly aid in fulfilling the task of making disciples, but they are not our primary focus. We live in a city of almost 500,000 people, in a province of almost 1.4 million people, and we are not aware of a single congregation of the Lord's church in the entire province. Our goal in 2022 was to begin to work to establish a sound, faithful congregation of the church of Christ, beginning in the city of Huancayo. To that end, we began establishing contacts and looking for people who wanted to study and obey the Word. Since then, we have had 22 baptisms, and we now have a consistent group of about 35 people meeting every Lord's Day for worship. In addition to Sunday worship, we have 10 group Bible studies and at least half a dozen individual studies on a weekly basis. Audrey herself teaches the children's Bible class on Sundays, leads a ladies' study every Tuesday, teaches three more studies at the women's prison every Friday, and meets with several individual women during the week. Truth be told, there is not enough time in the week to study with everyone who wants studies. We pray that the Lord will provide additional workers to participate in this plentiful harvest.

The work in Huancayo has progressed very well, especially over this past year and a half. However, there is no shortage of challenges to face. Peru has had lots of influences over the past 500 years since the Spanish arrived. Most people are nominally Catholic (80% of the population), so we are constantly facing issues of Roman Catholicism. However, although Catholicism is the majority, our main issues have been with the charismatic/Pentecostal movements, Christian cults (Mormonism, Jehovah's Witnesses, Seventh Day Adventism, and the Church of God World Missionary Society), and, to our surprise, modern-day Gnosticism. These groups have dramatically influenced Huancayo over the past 50 years. Our goal is to cut through the plethora of religious error and false doctrine and teach people the plain and simple doctrine of New Testament Christianity. Many are unwilling to leave their current religious groups, but we continue to sow the seed through the preaching and teaching of the Word and pray that there will be willing and honest souls to receive and obey it.

APRIL-JUNE 2026

As you may have read in our last newsletter, 2026 has been especially busy. In April we travelled to the US for the wedding of Audrey's sister. While in the States we visited over a dozen supporting congregations. We still had more places to go, but time did not allow. Thank you to all who allowed us to share an in-person mission report, and for the congregations we could not visit personally, we hope to see you next time we are in the States!

While in the US, the Huancayo congregation continued forward. They had a baptism while we were away. Fiorela, a former Jehova's Witness with whom we had been studying off and on for a couple of years, was baptized into Christ in May. We got back to Huancayo at the end of June and we have jumped right back into the work. Please continue to pray as we get re-settled, and we look forward to updating you as 2026 progresses!

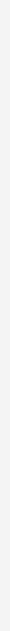
