We celebrated the New Year with celebrations across Huancayo. January begins the "summer vacation" here, so schools are closed and many people are travelling. Despite this, we remained overwhelmed with the needs of those around us. There is hardly a day that passes that we are not meeting with someone for Bible study or just to listen to a trial or struggle someone may be facing. A large part of ministry is simply being present for people as they face the difficulties of life. Through this relationship-building the door opens to share the Gospel and study God's word with people. January was fairly normal for us as we prepared for many exciting events that were headed our way in February and March. We continued with our weekly Bible studies and services which take up the majority of our time. We are excited to announce that there were **two baptisms** at the women's prison this month. Audrey has been leading Bible studies there for about 8 months to three different groups of women on Fridays, and Bertha and Flor decided to obey the Gospel. While prison ministry certainly has its challenges, we are grateful that there are those who wish to know the Lord and obey Him. Please be in prayer for these two new sisters in Christ, as well as for the rest of the women in the prison that their hearts may be open to the transformational power of the Gospel.

Of those in attendance, seven were from the congregation in the US and the rest were from Peru. Not only did we have church members and visitors from Huancayo, but there was a large group of women from two congregations in Lima who were able to attend as well. This was a beautiful time of fellowship and edification for all who participated, and after the retreat there was even a baptism! Dori, age 84, is a relative of two of the ladies who came from Lima, and she decided to be baptized after the event. We hope to facilitate events such as this one again in the future.

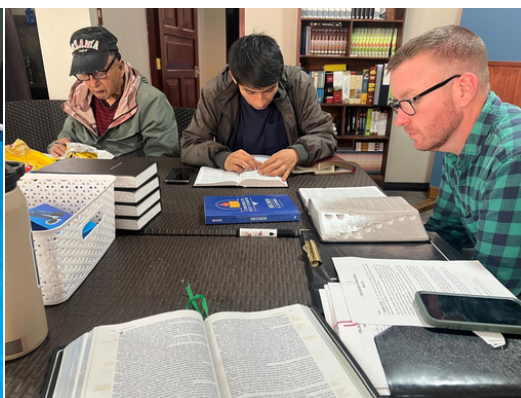
MARCH 2026

In March things stayed busy! We had a family from TN come to stay with us for a couple of weeks. The Danner family was able to participate in all of our day-to-day activities. They led numerous Bible studies while Daniel and Audrey translated for them. In addition to our normal studies, Jordan, who is a TN State Trooper, conducted a workshop at the police academy with about 250 cadets. We also had an “English conversation night” at a local coffee shop where Jordan and Rachel were able to meet a group of college-aged people and teach some English. This is an activity we do about once a month in order to meet new people and build relationships, and we were excited the Danners were here to participate. Our kids had a great time playing with the Danner’s three daughters. Playing with kids who speak english is a special treat for our children, so they were beyond excited to have that opportunity. We are so grateful the Danners made the sacrifice to come and spend these two weeks with us in Huancayo.

In March we also had **two new baptisms**! Luz is a young lady we have known for many years wo baptized into Christ after at a couple of years of study. She is a senior in high-school, so be in prayer as she begins a new stage of life entering adulthood, and especially pray for her as she begins her new spiritual life as a follower of Christ. In addition to Luz, another young man named Josef was baptized this month. We met Josef through a Gospel meeting that was held last July. Daniel has been meeting with him for about 8 months, usually multiple times a week. Josef just graduated college this past December, so be in prayer for him as he searches for a job and begins his Christian walk as well. **This makes 5 baptisms so far this year!**

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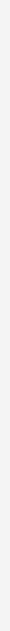
