During November we maintained our regular schedules, with multiple individual and group studies throughout the week. We added a few new personal studies to our weekly rotation. Josef is a young man who attends the university near our house. His mom has been attending the Wednesday studies for a while now and finally convinced her son to attend our meetings. Josef has many questions about the Bible and has an interest in being baptized. We ask that you keep him and his mother in your prayers as they continue to grow in their knowledge of the Bible.

During November we also had a large fellowship meal following Sunday worship. We decided to share our custom of Thanksgiving with the church members. December is a difficult month here, as many travel to be with family for the holidays or return to their hometowns while classes are out for a couple of months. We have definitely seen a decrease in numbers the last couple of weeks as many have left Huancayo, but we are eagerly awaiting their return in late January or early February. Please be in prayer for the families who will be traveling during this time. Pray that they make it back to us safely in a few weeks!

Though we have had a decrease in number we still have a week full of studies. Right now, Audrey meets with two ladies individually as well as her two group studies during the week and Daniel meets with multiple individuals and leads five group studies.
