The Perfect One in an Imperfect World

We live in an imperfect world. Every day we see the effects of sin, disappointment, sickness, suffering, broken relationships, and death. People fail us, and at times we fail others. Yet in the middle of an imperfect world, there is One who is perfect, Jesus Christ. Hebrews 4:15 reminds us that Jesus “was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.” He experienced hunger, weariness, rejection, sorrow, and temptation, but He never sinned. He was perfect in His character, perfect in His love, and perfect in His obedience to God.

Jesus came into this imperfect world for imperfect people. Romans 3:23 says, “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.” We cannot look to ourselves for perfection, because we have all fallen short. But God demonstrated His love by sending His Son to provide the way of salvation. Romans 5:8 says, “But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” The cross is the greatest evidence that God does not abandon us because we are imperfect. Instead, He offers us forgiveness through Christ.

Because Jesus is perfect, He is the perfect example for our lives. Peter tells us that Christ “suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps” (1 Peter 2:21). We will not live perfectly, but we can strive to live faithfully. When we stumble, we can turn to God in repentance and seek His forgiveness. First John 1:9 teaches, “If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

The world may never be perfect, but that does not mean Christians should simply accept the imperfections around us. We are called to be different. Jesus said, “You are the light of the world” (Matthew 5:14). In a world filled with darkness, Christians should let the light of Christ shine through their words, attitudes, actions, and daily lives. We cannot change everything that is wrong with the world, but we can allow Christ to change us.

One day, God will take His faithful children out of this imperfect world and bring them into a perfect home. Revelation 21:4 tells us, “And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying.” Until that day comes, let us keep our eyes upon Jesus, the perfect One, and faithfully follow Him. We may live in an imperfect world, but we serve a perfect Savior who offers us forgiveness, hope, and the promise of a perfect eternity.
