CRAZY COUPLE OF MONTHS

Since we arrived back in Huancayo, things have been crazy. We have experienced earthquakes, had multiple baptisms, and have tried to readjust to life in the mountains. While we have had many highs since we returned to Huancayo, we have also passed through many lows. We ask that you please be in prayer for the congregation here in Huancayo. It seems as though after every trip to the States there are always many fires to put out upon our return. This trip was no different. Please be in prayer for us as we do our best to navigate each of these situations and slowly try to gain momentum again. Our regular studies have all picked back up- our weekly ladies' study, two other mixed group studies at the church local (not including the study time we have after service on Sunday), the prison studies, and multiple individual studies. Attendance has remained consistent- we usually have about 35-40 people for Sunday worship. The kids have all done well returning to our normal routine. Levi and Charlie were excited to get back to school, and their teachers and classmates were just as excited to have them back!

EARTHQUAKES!

On July 18th we experienced an earthquake here in the valley. The epicenter was located in some of the smaller surrounding towns outside of the city. These little towns were hit very hard during this event and during the subsequent aftershocks. Most of the homes in that area are/were made of adobe. Several are now living without shelter, which is difficult given how cold our nights get here, and there have been multiple deaths from hypothermia. Several congregations and individuals donated funds to be used to help the victims! We want to thank each and every one of you for your kindness and generosity. Because of you we were able to deliver blankets, fresh water, and food supplies to these smaller towns. We hope to continue to visit these towns until there is no longer a need. Please be in prayer for the victims of the earthquake and that the smaller tremors will cease. Thankfully we did not experience any damage in the city, but we ask that you be in prayer for us that it will remain that way.

NEW SISTERS AND BROTHER IN CHRIST!

In the month of July, we had one baptism! Sofia is a young lady who has been attending our studies and worship services for almost a year with her family. Her family started attending with us last year as a result of receiving a flyer inviting them to one of our Bible conferences. We are so excited for her decision. Please be in prayer for her, her parents and her brother. We are hopeful her family members will all follow Sofia's lead and put on Christ in baptism.

In August we had three more baptisms! A married couple - Alessandro and Miryam - had been attending the Wednesday night studies off and on for almost a year. They both decided to be born again and put Christ on in baptism. Unfortunately, the following morning Alessandro was riding his bike and was struck by a car. The accident left him with several fractures, the most severe being in his femur. Because of the public healthcare system here, Alessandro has been waiting almost two weeks for the supplies to be shipped to Huancayo and continues waiting in the hospital for a surgery date to be scheduled. Please be in prayer for him and his wife. We will continue to provide updates on his condition on our Facebook page.

The third baptism we had in August was a woman named Kaite. She and her son have been attending worship and studies for a couple of months. They actually began attending while we were still in the United States. She decided to be baptized to begin her life in Christ. We ask for prayers for her and her son Aaron. We are so excited to have an extra kiddo in the kids class on Sunday. He is close in age to Caleb, which makes it even more exciting for Caleb!
